Report on Capacity Building Training Program on Preparation of Microplan under AJY on 7th and 8th April 2016

Introduction:

The tradition of conserving forest through informal village level institutions and social pressures exists in many villages of the state. In recent past for strengthening and supporting such community based initiatives, many significant efforts have been made by the Forest Department through the Odisha Forestry Sector Development Project Phase- I for improving the forest cover along with generating alternate livelihood avocations to reduce pressure on forest. The experience gained under Odisha Forestry Sector Development Project (OFSDP) reveals that with some support provided by the Government, the outcome will further improve both in terms of conservation and management of the natural resource as well as income generation activities.

Capacity building of village community as well as the partner NGOs is an important component of the scheme which is proposed to be achieved by imparting trainings on various site specific forestry, income generating and livelihood themes to the VSS/SHG members. As a part of the capacity building component a two days training module on microplanning is developed by PMU.

Micro Planning is a community based empowering process for preparing a road map for development and management of forest and livelihood enhancement of the forest dependent communities with properly defined roles and responsibilities of all stakeholders, clearly set targets and well discussed deadlines.

The Micro Plan shall be a comprehensive development plan with a special focus on forest and livelihood development. The micro plan shall cover both forest and nonforest areas managed by the VSS/ EDC. Micro plan shall integrate the needs of VSS/ EDC into comprehensive plan through analysis of current conditions, social assessment and interaction with the members, and with reference to the prescriptions of the Working Plan of the Forest Division and in confirmity with the 2015, VSS Resolution.

Training Program on Microplanning:

A two days capacity building training program has been conducted on Preparation of Microplan under AJY on 7th and 8th April 2016. The training was imparted in an interactive mode with lots of hands on to make it as participatory as possoble. To demistify the doubts about micoplanning adequate space was provided in each session for discussion and question answer.

Participants:

85 participants fromForest Department and P-NGOs from 3 forest divisions (Part – 1 Divisions: Keonjhar, Rourkela)(Part – 2 Divisions: Phulbani) (1 ACF, 1 FES, 1

Retired FES, 7 Range Officers, 16 Foresters, 14 Forest Guards, 15 Team Leaders and 30 Development Officers of the P NGOs) participated in the training programme the list of the participants are enclosed as Annexure I.

Training Objectives:

- 1. To enhance and improve conceptual and practical understanding of participants on concept of microplanning, the principles that guide participatory planning, and the tools for participatory microplanning.
- 2. Aquent the participants on various participatory rural appraisal tools and techniques to enable them to apply these tools for collection of required primary information which are essential for microplanning.
- 3. To enhance and improve conceptual understanding of participants on baseline data collection, PRA and developing forest & perspective plan for micro plan.

The Training:

During the two days capacity building training program on preparation of microplan under Ama Jangala Yojana at IMAGE, Siripur, Bhubaneswar on 7th and 8thApril 2016 total 7 technical sessions covering different steps and aspects of microplanning with examples has been covered.
